Doctors Without Borders/ Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is providing appropriate and timely medical and psychological care to the survivors of sexual assault and domestic violence, including children, through a community based clinic in North Delhi, Jahangir Puri.

The UMEED KI KIRAN CLINIC aims to increase access to quality treatment for survivors of sexual assault, who may develop medical and psychological complications. Care is delivered according to national protocols in a non-judgmental and confidential manner. The MSF team is also raising awareness on the importance of provision of timely medical and psychosocial care, in the community, through health education and outreach activities.

FOR SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, INCLUDING CHILDREN, THE CLINIC PROVIDES:

Medical treatment:

- ✓ Treatment to prevent contracting HIV
- ✓ Treatment to prevent sexually transmitted infections
- ✓ Prevention of unwanted pregnancy
- ✓ Treatment of physical injuries

Psychosocial services:

- ✓ Initial emotional support
- ✓ Follow up psychological support

Present at all times in the clinic:

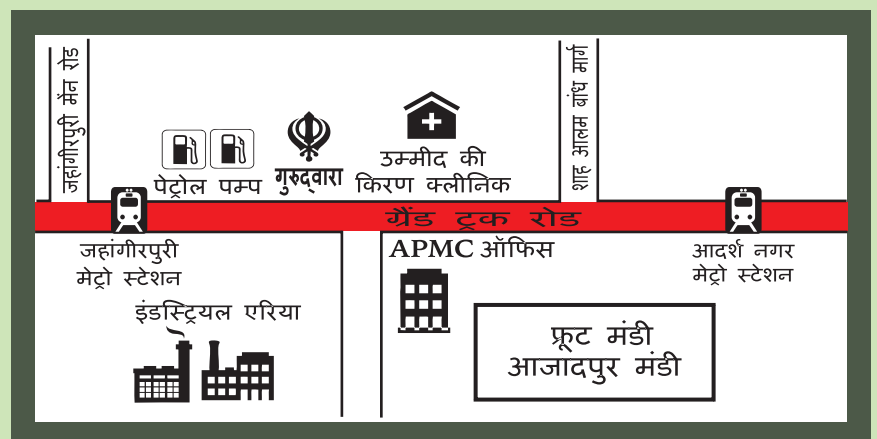
- ✓ Trained and qualified M.B.B.S doctors
